

# AGED RESIDENT KILLED BY CAR

**HENRY OLESON IS STRUCK  
WHILE WALKING ALONG  
ROAD AT WABMEME**

**Had Resided in Northern Michi-  
gan Since 1908. Funeral  
Plans Being Made**

An automobile accident last night brought death to the second Petoskey man within the week when Henry Oleson, aged 81, was instantly killed about 8:15 o'clock when struck by a car driven by Earl Whitney. The accident happened near Wabmeme. Mr. Oleson had been visiting his son, Eli Oleson, who resides north of Wabmeme and was returning to the home of his daughter, Marion Newman, who resides at Wabmeme, when the regrettable accident occurred. It is thought that Mr. Oleson became confused by a car approaching from the north, did not see the Whitney car which was approaching from the south, and stepped in the path of the Whitney car at a point where the road turns into Wabmeme from U. S. 131.

Mr. Oleson emigrated to this country from Denmark when a young man and spent the better years of his life in farming in different sections of Michigan. He came to northern Michigan in 1908 with his wife and family, and since the death of his wife, Dorothea Maria Oleson in 1927, he has lived with his children who reside in this city and in the close vicinity.

Surviving Mr. Oleson are Mrs. Henry J. Burch, Mrs. Marion Newman, Mrs. Hattie Schr, and Dorothy Oleson, of Grand Rapids, all daughters of the deceased, together with Eli Oleson and Daniel Oleson, sons of the deceased.
